Looking ahead:

This year, we are expanding our board of trustees structure to include committees with nonboard members to increase participation by the public.

In order to better serve our lower income patrons, we have removed fine-based restrictions of computer use and (on a trial basis) instituted a fine-free policy for late books.

We have started the first phase of the Ready to Read at NY Libraries Early Literacy program with the aim of gathering community needs information that will allow us to plan and implement appropriate programs.
