<u>September Statistics</u>: Check outs – 2,711; Borrowers – 400; Holds Satisfied – 569; New Cards Issued – 16; Computer sessions – 169; WiFi uses –476; Cossayuna WiFi – 95; Overdrive checkouts – 324; Kanopy – 70 Plays; Visitors to the library (door count) – 3015; Community service sessions – 26; Community service attendees – 178; Library programs/events (general) – 12; Library program/events attendees – 167; Early Childhood programs/services – 9; Early Childhood attendees – 126; Volunteer hours - 117; Farm 2 Library participants – 241; pounds of food waste diverted for compost – 426.6

KEY PRIORITIES:

Literacy Education Goal: Enhance and expand programs that provide community members with more broadly defined literacy-based learning opportunities

- Once again, we received a grant from the Home for Aged Women for Large Type books. This has allowed us to build a robust collection over the years, and I am glad to keep it going. Demand is high for these books.
- Emilly Sargent's Kindergarten Readiness program began earlier in October
- We will be giving out free books at our Halloween party 10/31 from 3-5

Lifelong Learning Goal: *Create innovative learning opportunities for community members of all ages* Programming updates:

- Adult and general audience programs coming up: SoulCollage workshop on 10/22; Halloween cider, donuts, and free books 10/31; Collection Connection get together (materials selection and wish list) for Children's materials on 10/27 and adult and YA on 11/10; Wildlife Ambassadors event on November 5th
- Professional Learning: Emilly Sargent will be attending one day of the NYLA conference in Saratoga on Nov 10th
- Professional Learning: I am visiting 4 libraries in the SALS service area on Tuesday 10/18, and I'd like to visit several more over the next few months

Preservation and Access to Local Historical Documents Goal: Enhance access to an expanded collection of paper, photo, and digital sources and documents related to the history of the greater Greenwich community.
