- 4,656 borrowers checked out 31,053 books, used 6,233 WiFi connections, downloaded 3,498 eBooks and audiobooks, and streamed 877 films.
- We installed six Little Free Libraries about town, thanks to Scouts BSA Troop 6027.
- Patrons composted 3,643 pounds of food and organic waste through our partnership with Adirondack Worm Farm.
- 2,037 people enjoyed fresh fruits and vegetables through Farm-2-Library.
- We started five days of weekly library programming for ages 0-18.
- We hosted weekend and evening events such as Endless Summer and Halloween parties, educational workshops, author events, panel discussions, and more.
- 102 people of all ages read 196,395 pages for our Summer Reading Challenge.
- We continued our longtime partnership with the Osteo Busters exercise class through Warren/Washington RSVP.
- Community members booked library space for 2,494 people to attend 306 events.

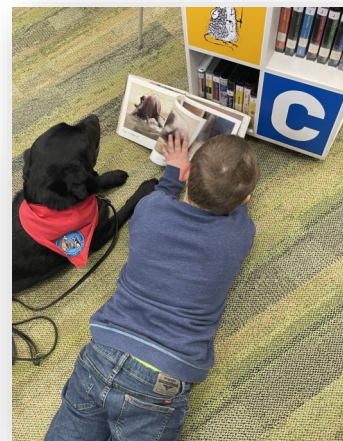
